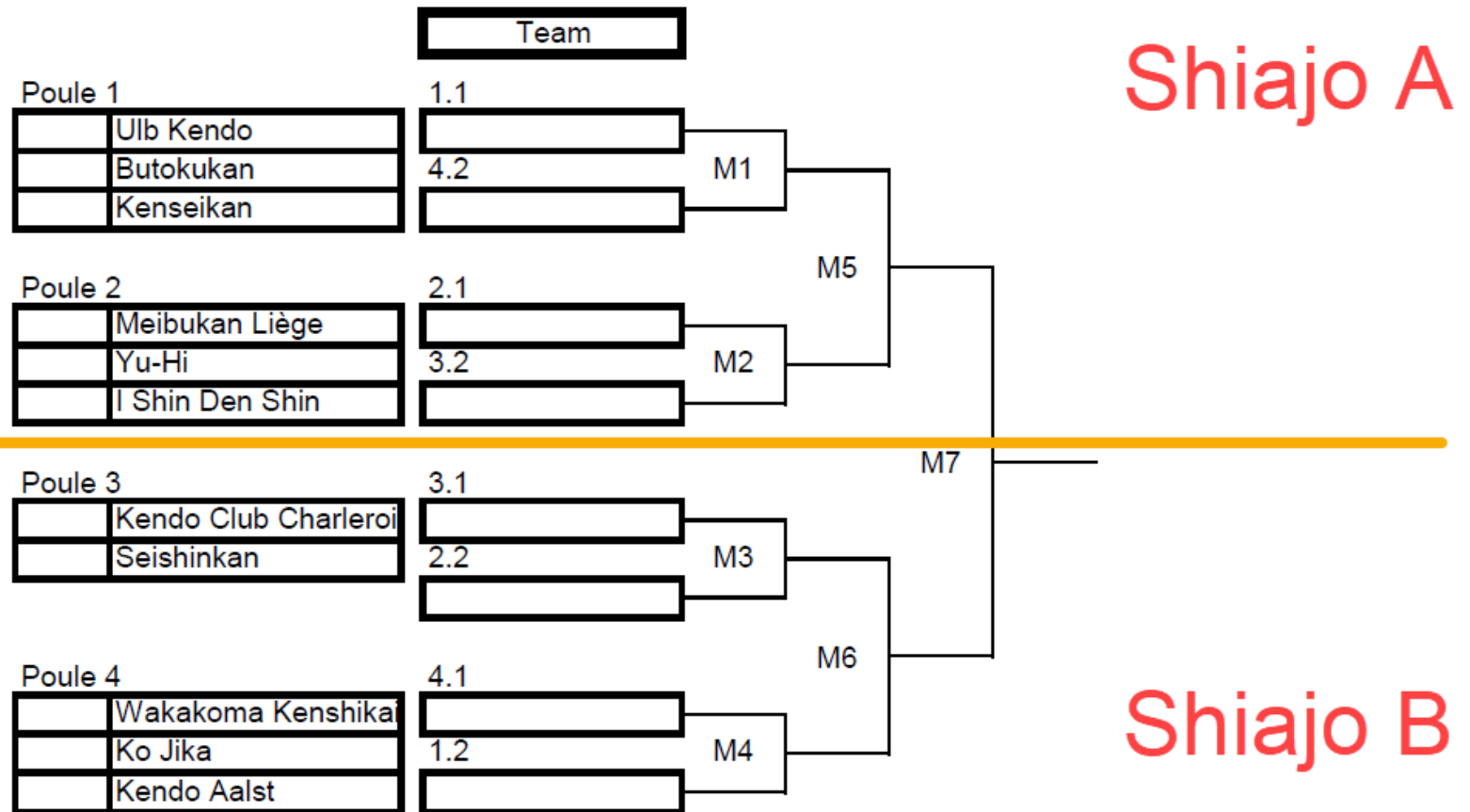

Rules & Organization

Organisation of Belgian Kendo Championships.

Who can take part?

Any correct registered member of VKIJF & BKR since at least one (1) year, at least 18 years old at the day of the tournament and holding at least the 3rd kyu grade in kendo.

Foreign members who are taking part in any other National Championship are not eligible for taking part in the Belgian Championships.

Both regional federations will check the list of participants before the final drawing. All participants who are selected for the final drawing are supposed to be regular members and cannot be taken out of the grids afterwards.

Participation in the team matches is supposed to be sent in time for the drawing and each dojo manager is supposed to pay the full amount of the subscription fees (25€) by bank to ABKF account BE76 0011 1992 3095 before this moment (D-day – 14). Dojo who haven't paid their subscription fees on time will be considered as not taking part in the event. Refund of subscription fees is possible only with the permission of ABKF Board and must be asked by letter or e-mail with clear reason until maximum one week after the event.

All dojo member candidates who haven't officially subscribed in the tournament will be refused in the current event. All dojo who aren't not following these rules will be taken out of the competition after the final drawing. Each dojo will also provide at least two (2) kakariin.

All participants are supposed to have correct knowledge of the regional regulations concerning doping and other specific rules.

Drawing will be held at ABKF HQ or at any place chosen by the ABKF Board.

Belgian Kendo “Team” Championships.

Each dojo (club) can register one (1) team and minimum two (2) kakariin.

A team consist of 7 players which hold at least the rank of 3rd kyu. A minimum of four (4) players is the limit for valid participation.

For the first match of the tournament the positions as filled-in at the moment of subscription will be used. Order can be changed from the second match only but first two players remain kyu grades.

At least 2 shiaiyo will be set up.

A minimum of 11 referees will be necessary for the tournament (1 shinpan-cho – 2 shinpan-shunin – 8 shinpan).

The rules used for this competition are the common FIK-rules. Exceptions to these will be specified by shinpan-cho at the beginning of the day.

Specifications regarding referees:

Each dojo will provide their list of candidate referees.

Shinpan-cho will be assigned by ABKF.

Shinpan-cho will be informed about the global organisation at least one week before the event and will have the highest possible rank.

He will be assisted by one (1) shinpan shunin for each shiai. These will be selected also in accordance with shinpan-cho.

The minimum rank of these referees will be at least 6th dan. All other referees will hold at least 4th dan.

Referees should avoid refereeing the team of their own dojo, an exception is made if no other referee is available.

Referees should wear formal dress and bring their own referee flags.

Technical part:

All dojo can enter one (1) team composed by male or female players who are at least regular members of BKR or VKIJF since one year. All team members must be minimum 18 years old at the day of the tournament with minimum rank of 3rd kyu.

All competitors are supposed to wear correct fitting equipment with identification of family name in romanji and bring their own shiai-meijirushi (red & white ribbon). They use these correctly by themselves during the entire competition.

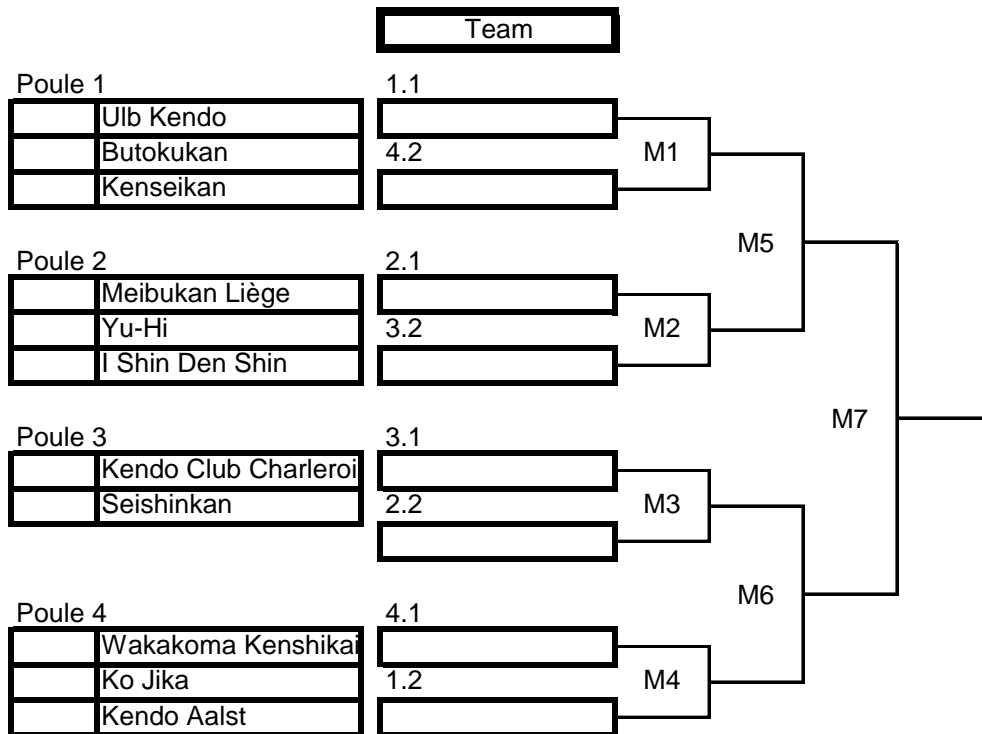
All shiai will be held in 4 minutes during the entire tournament except for the semi-finals & finals where the maximum time will be 5 minutes.

First and second position in the team out of 7 players will be mandatory kyusha. From 3rd up to 7th position (Captain), kyusha as well as yudansha are eligible but 7th position (captain - taisho) must be filled.

Decision is made by counting the number of victories and if these are equal, the number of scored points.

If at the end of the entire team matches the winner is still not declared; a supplementary match will be organised. Decision will be made by ippon-shobu. At this moment encho will be possible without time limit. The concerned teams are free to choose among their team members their representative player.

Each participating dojo (club) must provide at least two (2) kakariin. These persons must be aware of the basics of kendo shiai management.
